## Engine Warranty and Engine Installation Instructions

### Please read completely before installation

Affordable Powertrain, LLC wants EVERY customer to be completely satisfied with their engine purchase. APTLLC also warrants to the original buyer that each used engine sold is protected from defects in material and workmanship when properly installed and under normal use and service for the period of time and distance to the terms and conditions as following unless otherwise noted: **THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER LABOR, TOWING, LOSS OF INCOME, RENTAL CAR.**

#### Terms:

In the unlikely event there is a problem with any part purchased, Affordable Powertrain LLC is at its option either to repair or replace the defective unit only. All used engines are sold as LONG BLOCKS only. No warranty is covered on any attached accessories. Parts such as intake or exhaust manifolds, carburetor, distributor, fuel system, alternator, starter, water pump, thermostat, clutch, flywheel, timing belt of belt driven engines, electrical sensors or electrical components. APPEARANCE OF USED ENGINES IS NOT WARRANTIED.

To get the maximum life out of your used engine AND to validate your Warranty the following items MUST be done. Without completing them there is NO Warranty. Keep all receipts. No exceptions!

1. Engines must be installed within 30 days of receipt otherwise the warranty is invalid. Installation must be completed by the purchaser or an ASE certified mechanic at a licensed facility.
2. All belt-driving engines are required to install a new timing belt and set the right timing before installation is done. Keep receipt for timing belt
3. Replace oil and filter. Change oil after first 500 miles then every 3000. Keep all oil change receipts and records. Failure to do so will invalidate any warranty. No exceptions Replace all tune-up items (spark plugs, fuel and air filter).Check and adjust valves and timing to factory settings.
4. Thermostat and Water pump must be replaced. Keep receipts. Fuel lines need to be checked for debris and flow. Pick-up screen to oil pump must be replaced or cleaned. Check radiator completely. OVERHEATING, FOR ANY REASON, INVALIDATES WARRANTY..
5. Prime lubrication system to avoid dry start. Manually turn over engine crankshaft several times before installing. Failing to do so WILL invalidate warranty
6. Installer must replace the rear main seal; inspect all other seals and gaskets prior to installing the engine. Replace if necessary. Blown head gaskets are not covered under this warranty.

#### IMPORTANT NOTES:

A) All warranties are null and void if engine is installed in anything other than original application. Any cancellations must be done within 30 days of order and will be charged a 25 percent restocking fee and the freight charges both ways

B) When your part arrives inspect it COMPLETELY for any damage incurred during shipping. Any and all damage must be noted on the delivery ticket before the driver leaves.

C) Customer is required to keep accurate records and RECEIPTS of all above requirements. No receipts, no warranty, no exceptions.

D) If any legal claim arises concerning the above conditions both parties agree that the State and County for meeting be in Duval County, Florida. Florida law shall be the determining factor.
